The Third Annual Vintage Motorcycle Show took place August 20th at the Parkvale Community Hall. It was a family friendly event as some of the younger kids were able to touch and even sit on a motorcycle. A spur of the moment ride to the Parkvale Lodge by a dozen riders got waves from those residents waiting for the Ride By.

Many of the motorcycles had been restored, showcasing both the mechanical knowledge and artistry of their owners. The older models are fragile compared to the high tech models of today; these had evolved from bicycles only a few decades before.

The Vintage Motorcycle group thanks the Parkvale Community Association for partnering to support this well-attended annual event. On display were thirty or so motorcycles ranging from very early 1930's to more modern touring machines.
